Then in conclusion and discussion, some sort of theoretical link between depression and SPA might be added. - Depressed patients are chosen, but criteria for diagnoses, or questionnaires used for that are not mention nor explained. - Stress in patients has not been measured either with questionnaires or tests. - There is no reference at all to the CRH (cortisol release hormone) that is very related to stress and depression. Since blood samples were taken and only those, then more analyses might have been done.
