The latter is strongly suggested to remove all confounders.</p> <p>2) A summary table should be included in the result section which classifies perception and practice into “good” and “bad” as stated in the methodology.</p> <p>3) The statements that link men to use of oral contraceptives and implants should be clarified by the author. Do men use oral contraceptives or reference is to the female partners' usage?</p> <p>4) All corrections pointed out on tables 3,4,5 should be carried out</p>	
<u>Minor</u> REVISION comments	Other comments pointed out in the manuscript should be attended to appropriately.
