<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>The article is interesting and useful for researchers and clinicians. It investigates the utility of two non-invasive exploration methods for liver steatosis and fibrosis. Moreover, it underlines the additional benefits of multiparametric MRI (objectivity, non-influence of excessive adipose tissue measurements, liver iron content estimation).</p> <p>The authors should mention whether patients have signed an informed consent prior to entering the study.</p> <p>The authors should add to the discussion chapter a sentence on the transient elastography (FibroScan (TM), TE) with a controlled attenuation parameter (CAP) that has demonstrated good accuracy in quantifying the levels of hepatic steatosis and fibrosis also in obese patients with NAFLD, using the obese-specific XL probe.</p> <p>The results could be easier to track in a few tables. It is difficult to follow the string of figures and data in the text.</p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	The small grammatical errors need to be corrected (eg, patients with only patients ...).	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	The number of patients is small.
