This should be corrected in the text of paper and also in the legend of the figure. Appearance of choroid vessels is a normal variation in the fundus pictures.</p> <p>REFERENCES: Writing the recent references of case reports at appropriate place in the paper will make this case report more complete and informative for readers.
